Howland's Rules

- You are personally responsible for following all state and local rules and recommendations related to COVID safety while traveling to and from the Cove, and while using the shore facilities. These rules change frequently, so please check them. The Club Manager can assist you, if in doubt.
- When on the dock, use of a facemask is *required at all times*. Please use the hand sanitizer placed at the top and bottom of the ramp, to mitigate contamination of the hand rails.
- While this is not a new rule, please do not enter Camp property, and transit directly to and from the Cove on the beach. Facemasks are also *required when passing by the Camp property*, because guests may be using the beach areas.
- Consider politely reminding other users of the dock (who may not be LAYC members) of the Camp's rules about use of the dock if you observe them without masks. California law generally ensures ingress and egress to the mean high tide zone, but the Camp has the ability to "raise the drawbridge" and generally deny access to the dock for all. Hey, this might also be an opportunity to invite them to consider joining the Club!
- At the Cove, the tables have been "distanced." As on the mainland, social distancing of at least 6 feet is required, except for family-resident groups. Please wear facemasks around the Cove when you are not eating or drinking.
- Hand sanitizer is not generally available at the Cove, so please bring your own and use it regularly.
- Please limit access to the barbecue in a manner that allows for social distancing of at least 6 feet. As a general rule, this means that no more than three persons should be at the barbecue at one time (properly spaced, of course), but more may creatively use the grill surfaces at one time if you alternate. This is not much different than how we always use the barbecue but has the added dimension of social distancing.
- We discourage use of the volleyball court and fire pit, as it is inherently difficult to use either of these and maintain social distancing.
- If you bring your dog, please clean up after it. In particular, do not allow your Best Friend to enter or soil Camp property – this has been a particular problem recently. Please keep your dog on a leash when transiting the dock or the beach, or when using the Cove or when sharing the tabled areas when people are around. Early morning walks off leash is allowed (while the beach is empty) as long as all deposits are picked up.
- Use caution when considering dinghy raft-ups, etc., to ensure social distancing.
- The heads are not being cleaned, so you are responsible for cleaning after use. Remember, the head on your boat should still be your primary facility.
- Please pack out everything you carry to the Cove and dispose of it on the mainland or Two Harbors. I don't believe that the traditional "Salad Bowl" garbage runs are operating currently, so plan accordingly. In particular, please do not leave garbage at the Cove or attempt to dispose of it at the Camp. Remember, leave only footprints and take only photographs.
- Take photos of your mask use, as this is an historic time worth recording (just kidding, I wanted to see if you would read all the rules!)
